



POOL & RECREATION ROOM RULES

Authority of Lifeguards

Life Guards have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations and are empowered to impose on the spot penalties when necessary. Serious and/or repeat violations will be reported to the Club Manager for additional action as deemed necessary. Management reserves the right to deny use of the facilities to anyone at any time for inappropriate behavior or use of the facilities.

Pool Hours

Lakeside:	Monday -Sunday	10:30 a.m. – 9:00 pm.
Turnstone:	Monday – Sunday	11:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

1. Pool hours of operation may be changed on a temporary basis for swim meets, special events and pool maintenance.
2. Openings or closings due to inclement weather are left to the discretion of the Head Life Guard and/or Club Manager.

Admission

1. Admission to the pool area is only permitted with membership cards – NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Loss of Membership Card(s) should be reported immediately to the Kiosk Attendant or Club Manager. A replacement card will be issued for \$5.00 per card.
3. Use of a person's membership card by a different person will result in the suspension of pool privileges for 2 weeks.
4. All persons using the pools at the Lake Jeanette Recreation Association facilities do so at their own risk. The Lake Jeanette Recreation Association assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use.

Guests

1. Guests must be accompanied by a member and pay the posted guest fee upon entry to the pool.
2. Members are only allowed to bring (4) guests per day to the pool.
3. Each guest may visit a total of 12 times per year, but only 1 time in any seven day period.

Safety

1. There will be 10 minute rest periods every hour for all swimmers under 16 years of age. When the whistle is blown, all swimmers under age 16 are to get out of the water and behind the blue pool deck line.
2. The following items are prohibited in the pool area: **Glass containers - Smoking or tobacco products - Chewing gum - Pets**
3. No swimming in the diving area – except when the diving boards are closed.
4. Only 1 person on each diving board at a time.
5. Must follow all rules posted at the Water Slides - children under 48" tall must be closely supervised by an adult if climbing stairs to water slide or using water slide.
6. Swimming devices and aids are only allowed in the baby pool.
7. All children under age 11 must be accompanied by a member 16 years of age or older.
8. All food and beverages must remain outside the blue pool deck line at all times.

Health

1. Shower before entering the pool – outdoor showers are available on deck.
2. Persons with skin eruptions, open sores, bandages, etc. are not permitted to use the pool.
3. Trash and recycling must be placed in proper receptacles provided on the pool deck.
4. Pets are not allowed.
5. All swimmers must wear proper bathing suits (no cut-offs, tennis shorts, or frayed clothing) in pool.
6. **Children who are not yet potty trained must wear appropriate swim diapers with a no leak rubber lining.**

Recreation Room

The Recreation Room and equipment are provided for the enjoyment of all members. The Life Guards have the authority to close the Recreation Room from use at any time due to misuse or abuse of the room and any recreational equipment. Food and beverages are not allowed in the recreation room.
